**OFF LICENCE**

Sections 17 to 20 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

39/OFF/015/2020

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **I.S. DHILLON AND SONS LIMITED** (the licensee) is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at **688-690 Main Street, Palmerston North**, and known as **"BIG BARREL"**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol, free as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

If this licence is not endorsed under section 40 of the Act, the licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

**CONDITIONS**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day.
- (b) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:

**Monday to Sunday      8.00 am      to      10.00 pm**

- (c) **The whole of the premises is designated as Supervised.**
- (d) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers, while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample.
- (e) A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises.
- (f) At each principal entrance to the premises a sign must be displayed stating the hours of business during which the premises are open for the sale of alcohol.

**THE LICENSED PREMISES**

The premises situated at 688-690 Main Street, Palmerston North is more precisely identified in a plan received by the Palmerston North District Licensing Committee on 12 November 2020. The entrance from the Church Street carpark is designated as the principal entrance.

**DURATION**

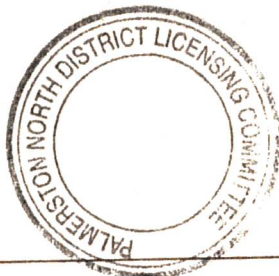
Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force-

- until the close of the period for which it is renewed; or
- if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before it would otherwise expire, until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it is renewed.
